EXCHANGE CLUB COVENANT OF SERVICE

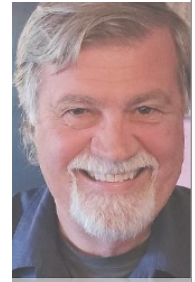
Accepting the divine privilege of single and collective responsibility as life's noblest gift, I covenant with my fellow Exchangites:

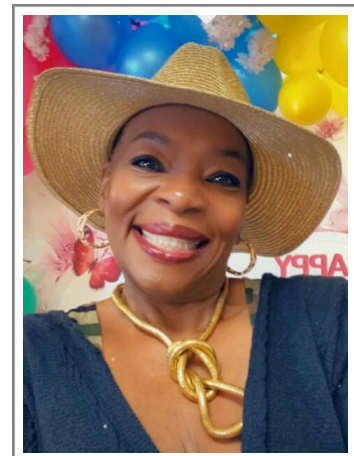
